United Way of the CSRA mobilizes the caring power of our community to make lasting change on the issues that matter most in our region. We want to ensure that children, young adults, and families have the tools and resources they need to achieve their maximum potential.

- 18% more people were assisted with mental health services than in 2021.
- Families remaining stably housed through disaster assistance and emergency assistance programs increased by 140%



- 96% of the children in our early education programs achieved their developmental milestones. That is a 23% improvement from last year!
- We enrolled 70% more children in early education programs this year over last year.



- 83% of the middle school students transitioned to high school on time successfully.
- There was a 95% increase in youth involved in job skills training programs.



- 82% Employment rate for individuals in our job training programs.
- Young adults and Adults enrolled in credentialing programs had a 69% achievement rate.
