What do citizen review volunteers do in just 12-15 hours each year?

- Receive training on how we conduct our Community Investment Process and what is expected of them in this role.
- Review agency proposals and financial statements.
- Conduct agency site visits.
- Recommend funding allocations for each program for the Board of Directors' approval.
